

When you have the following documents ready, call 724-9731 and ask for Sue. If you qualify, she will set up your first appointment.

Loudon Food Pantry Assistance Application. Make sure it's completed.

Proof of your mailing address. Bring in something with your name and mailing address on it. An ID, property tax bill, car registration, etc. Junk mail is not acceptable.

Proof that everyone in your household lives there.

For everyone that is **18 years of age or older** bring in something that has the person's name and current address on it. Junk mail is not acceptable.

For everyone **17 years of age or younger** bring in a Birth Certificate or Social Security card.

Proof of all monies coming into the household (including young adults). Bring in pay stubs, proof of social security, proof of social security disability, proof of alimony, proof of any retirement benefits, proof of unemployment benefits, proof of any other monies coming into your household)

Proof of any services you are currently getting. Some of the common ones are...

(CSFP) Commodity Supplemental Food Program - The acceptance letter is proof.

Food Stamps – The letter you receive from them is proof.

Fuel Assistance – The acceptance letter is proof.

Electric Assistance – The acceptance letter is proof.

(SSI) Supplemental Security Income - Notice from Social Security that you get at the beginning of the year.

Subsidized Housing (Rental Subsidy) – HUD – Your rental agreement which shows the rental adjustment.

WIC – WIC acceptance letter, WIC Coupons, or WIC Card.
